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## Instructions for Use



1. Identify the point of bleeding and apply direct pressure. Swab excess blood where practical.



**2.** Tear open CELOX packet.



3. Immediately pour entire contents of pouch to fill the wound above skin level. Additional packs may be used if necessary.



4. Cover and apply FIRM pressure directly to wound for 5 minutes. If bleeding persists, apply additional pressure until bleeding stops.



- **5.** Secure with a dressing to maintain pressure on the wound. Discard any remaining CELOX granules.
- **6.** Transfer patient to Medical Facility as soon as possible
- 7. Show empty pack to medical personne

## ATTENTION MEDICAL EACH ITY DEDSONNEL

- 1. Physically remove CELOX Granules from the wound and any loose surface granules
- Fully flood entire wound area with sterile saline irrigation solution.
- Proceed with normal irrigation and/or suction.
